









	Prezi	- is a “web-based” or “in the cloud” application (delivered and saved entirely online) that lets you create multimedia presentations.		
	Internet browser	Prezi can be used directly from an internet browser (e.g. Firefox, Internet Explorer, Chrome, Safari) without the need to install anything.		
	Share	To collaborate (work at the same time) e-mail the link to a friend		
	Copyright law	- All borrowed materials are mandated to be referenced, so student’s presentations comply with the law.		
	Canvas	-the background of a Prezi		
	Multimedia	What can be added to a Prezi? - Text, video, sound, and images		
	Transformation Zebra	Move, scale and rotate		
	Center of zebra	- moves objects		
	Outer ring	- rotates objects		
	Inner Ring	- size and scale objects		
	Frames	- are containers for objects in your Prezi. You can use frames to show multiple items together in your path. You can also use frames to group items together.		
	Paths	- the direction in which you plan to present (what text, video, sound, or image will the audience see next)		
	Images	To download images they must be one of these file types: .GIF, .JPEG or PNG
